## **Women's Level 3.5 High Intensity Residential Treatment**

**Populations Served:** Women ages 18 and over who are at risk of losing their children to foster care as a result of their substance use. Pregnant women are given priority admission.

**Hours of Services:** 24 hours a day

**Days of Services:** Monday to Sunday

**Frequency of services:** At least 40 hours of clinical services a week, 6 hours a day Monday to Friday and 5 hours a day Saturday and Sunday.
